COMMUNITY INVITED TO FREE GOSPEL FEST

The Community Gospel Fest and back-to-school backpack collection is one of the many Alden Princeton and Alden Wentworth outreach programs offered throughout the year. Every year for the past four years, school children living in the Englewood community have benefited from the generous donations of employees at the two rehabilitation centers. This year, the facilities expect to give away more than 200 backpacks to youngsters who live in the neighborhood as part of their completely voluntary back-to-school backpack distribution.
